Students who have applied for scholarships will be reviewed by the Faculty Scholarship Award Committee in April. Students will be notified via e-mail if they are to be awarded a scholarship after the committee has made their final decision. The criteria for students being awarded scholarships will consist of the student's cumulative GPA and participation performance in the MCMP Program.

Available scholarships:

Eugene Carr Urban Planning Scholarship Fund:

A scholarship fund established in 2008 by a gift from the American Planning Association and individuals in honor of Gene Carr for the College of Architecture + Planning. The Gene Carr Endowed Scholarship Fund shall be given annually to a Master's student who demonstrates outstanding academic potential in the City and Metropolitan Planning graduate programs.

City & Metropolitan Planning Scholarship Fund:

A scholarship fund established in 2008 to manage donations for scholarships in the newly reorganized Department of City & Metropolitan Planning in College of Architecture + Planning.

Women in Transportation Scholarship:

CONDITIONS OF AWARD:

Scholarship recipients must be matriculated students working toward a post-baccalaureate or baccalaureate degree and registered for at least nine credit hours of work approved by the College of Architecture + Planning each semester. Students holding a scholarship must maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA. Failure to maintain these conditions will result in loss of the scholarship and require repayment of any portion of tuition that might have been waived.
